## Student Author Contract

The following agreement must be signed and returned to the *Indiana University Journal of Undergraduate Research (IUJUR)* before a manuscript can be accepted for publication.

- In consideration of publication in *IUJUR* of the work currently titled \_\_\_\_\_ (the “Work”) and authored by \_\_\_\_\_ (“Your Name”), *IUJUR* may, without cost, publish, reproduce, distribute, create derivative works from and otherwise use the Work in any form or medium, whether now known or hereafter developed for the entire duration of any such right.
- The Author attests that all the facts contained in the Work are true and accurate and that all research and investigation conducted for the purpose of the Work abides by the guidelines and regulations set by the Institutional Review Board and the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee.
- The Author warrants and represents that the Work is original and does not infringe upon any copyright, proprietary, or personal right of any third party. If the Work contains any material that is owned or controlled by a third party (for instance, images used in the article), the Author warrants and represents that he/she has obtained permission for its use and that the material is clearly acknowledged within the text.
  - Note:** Please be aware that many journals require exclusive rights to research that they publish. If you plan to publish research submitted to *IUJUR* in another journal at a later date, it is important that you are conscious of the other journal’s policy regarding exclusivity of rights.
- Ownership of the copyright shall remain with the Author, subject to *IUJUR*’s use and the rights granted by the Creative Commons license assigned by the Author. **A Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial 4.0 International (CC BY-NC 4.0) license will be applied to the published Work unless otherwise indicated below.**
  - The CC BY-NC 4.0 license (<https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc/4.0/>) lets others remix, tweak, and build upon the published Work non-commercially, and although the new works must also acknowledge the original *IUJUR* publication and be non-commercial, they don’t have to license their derivative works on the same terms.

This agreement may not be revoked without the express written consent of both parties, justifiable reasoning for revocation, and permission from the *IUJUR* Editor-in-Chief and Managing Editor.
